I wanted to take this opportunity to provide you with a further update on the progress of the A43 works and the Towcester relief road.

Phase 1 of the programme commenced in November and we have now completed the vegetation clearance. We have also installed temporary crossovers in the central reserve of the A43.

We are now pleased to announce details for Phases 2 and 3 of these works as follows:

- Phase 2: 6 January 2025 – 14 May 2025 A43 Southbound closed; the Northbound carriageway will operate as a contraflow.
- Phase 3: End of May 2025 – Mid June 2025 – A43 Southbound and Northbound lane 2 closure

The road will be fully open again in time for the MotoGP which we recognize is an important event in the Silverstone calendar.

A 24/7 emergency recovery service for vehicle breakdowns within the working area will be provided throughout the period of these works.

We understand that construction activities can be disruptive, and we are committed to minimizing the impact on local businesses and residents. During the construction period, there may be temporary road closures and diversions. We will ensure that clear signage is in place to guide traffic and that access to properties is maintained at all times.
