### Defibrillator 1

It is now registered with 'The Circuit – The National Defibrillator Network', with the postal and directional address of:

Village Postal Sorting Office  
Church Street  
Silverstone  
NN12 8UW

From the village centre, go down Church Street and it is situated behind Crofts Store, on the right-hand side of the road, on the wall immediately adjacent to the village postal sorting office.

Although it has been registered it is not in full working order as pads need to be replaced. These are on order.

As well as the Parish Clerk, all staff in Crofts know the code for the keypad in an emergency, however the first port of call is always to dial 999 and ask for help.

### Defibrillator 2

This will be situated in the old telephone box on Brackley Road, close to the layby. The Clerk is in discussions with National Grid to ascertain what power supply if any there is there, as electricity is needed for the lighting of the external security container.

Once the defibrillator is in place it will be registered with The Circuit – The National Defibrillator Network, for use in an emergency.
